



Hello to Parents of Students in 5th & 6th grades!

I wanted to send some information out to you regarding our 5th & 6th grade Sunday School program.

Club 56 is our program for 5th & 6th graders and meets in Room #205 (west 2nd floor hallway). It's an amazing program which takes Sunday School to the next level, preparing the children for their years in our Youth programming. These students will be challenged with the material, have the opportunity to dig deep in the Word, spend time in small groups, participate in music worship, fellowship with each other during quarterly social events as well as have the opportunity to go to summer camp.

Our Club 56 Team is led by Ryann Henry and the students will spend two years studying the OT followed by the NT. Our desire is to ensure these students have a solid Biblical foundation as well as a clear understanding of why they believe what they believe. In short, we want these students to "own their faith".

Another way we seek to accomplish this goal is by offering 56 JAM, which is our Sunday evening ministry (during Oasis) for this age group. It has more of a Youth Group feel. This year, we are studying 'The Genesis Project' which is a study that seeks to teach a Biblical Worldview using some Answers in Genesis curriculum. It's a nice compliment to the adult study, The Truth Project, which we encourage all parents to be a part of as it's offered if you haven't already. 56 JAM is led by Shannon Ackerman. This study runs during the school year, during Oasis (5:30 -7pm).

In regards to Sunday **mornings**, here are some KEY THINGS you will need to know:

- **Club 56 meets during the 11:00AM hour ONLY.** There will be no class offered for this age group during 8am or 9:30am. Pastor Steve feels like by this age students need to begin attending the main worship service. I encourage you to worship as a family during 9:30am and then go to Sunday School during the 11am service.
- **Parents do *not* need to personally drop Club 56ers off or pick them up afterwards.** Once your child has been enrolled into our electronic child check-in system, they may check themselves in each week at the computer station in their classroom. With age comes more privileges, but also more responsibility. :) Please plan a location for your child to meet you after class.
